Eurodoc Open letter to European Parliament on Horizon Europe



Eurodoc has sent an [open letter](#) to the members of the European Parliament on the [proposal](#) for a regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing Horizon Europe – the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation for 2012-2027, that will succeed Horizon 2020. Eurodoc calls on Members of the European Parliament to double the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) and European Research Council (ERC) budgets, reduce research barriers, put science first, and strengthen equality, humanities and open science in Horizon Europe.
