Doctoral Candidate Card to Promote Social Guarantees for PhDs in Ukraine



Ukrainian junior researchers started a new public initiative to improve the social guarantees and support of doctoral candidates in Ukraine and submitted a petition to the Ukrainian Government. They proposed to introduce a #DoctoralCandidateCard and social

guarantees for doctoral candidates (e.g. discounts on transport services, on cultural, sports events, medical insurance, support for the doctoral candidates with children, etc.) and gave a proposal for legal acts amendment. Read more...
