### Learn More About Eurodoc in the Recently Release Annual Report



For the first time in Eurodoc history, the annual report 2020/2021 is now available publicly. This decision was made during the Eurodoc Annual General Meeting, on 16-17 July 2021. Eurodoc's outgoing President [Giulia Malaguamera](#) welcomes this decision: "The Eurodoc administration 2020/2021 wanted to increase the transparency of the voluntary contribution that the team performed during this year, and we are very happy for the positive support of all our members!". ### Eurodoc Welcomes the Changes Made To the Family Allowance under Horizon Europe 2021-27



Eurodoc applauds the newest changes made to the [Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions](#) (MSCA) regarding the family allowance benefits. Under [Horizon Europe](#) 2021-27 R&D programme, MSCA fellows will receive a €660 monthly family allowance, corresponding to an increase of €500 compared to previous program. The family allowance will also be made available to researchers whose parental status changes during their project and the definition of family will become more inclusive to ensure that researchers in LGBT+ couples can access EU financial support. Eurodoc's outgoing president [Giulia Malaguamera](#) and incoming head [Agnieszka Żyra](#) applauded these important changes, that would allow MSCA-funded early career researchers "to be treated the same as their peers with family, and set a standard for others' funding programmes in terms of social benefits". 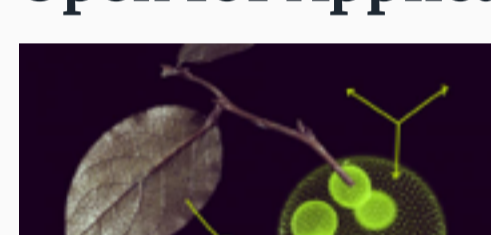

### The MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships 2021 is Now Open for Applications



The [2021 call for the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions Postdoctoral fellowships](#) is now open. If you hold a PhD and wish to carry out your research abroad and develop your career, you can submit your application before 12 October 2021. All disciplines are eligible for Postdoctoral Fellowships, however you must have no more than eight years experience in research, from the date of the award of the PhD degree. ### 10th Call for the European Young Researchers Award

Deadline: 17 September 2021, 12:00 CET



The 2022 call for The European Young Researchers' Award ([EYRA](#)), granted by EuroScience, is now open. Two prizes, for a PhD candidate and a postdoctoral fellow, will be granted at the biennial EuroScience flagship event, EuroScience Open Forum (ESOF). ### Apply for the PASIFIC Postdoctoral Fellowship Programme!

Deadline: 30 December 2021, 12:00 CEST.



We are happy to announce that the [PASIFIC Call 2](#) will be open from 15 September to 30 December 2021! Interested scholars of any nationality and representing all research disciplines will have an opportunity to apply for attractive 2-year postdoctoral fellowships at 69 institutes of the Polish Academy of Sciences and the Institute of Molecular and Cell Biology in Warsaw.

The PASIFIC fellows will be offered a monthly allowance of approx. €2,500 net. Those, who decide to come to Poland together with their families, may be entitled to an additional family allowance. In addition, they will be granted a budget of up to €60,000 for direct research costs.

To apply for the PASIFIC fellowships, candidates must be in possession of at least a doctoral degree or have 4 years of documented full-time equivalent research experience. Also, they must comply with the MSCA mobility rule and have not carried out their main activities in Poland for more than 12 months during the three years prior to the call's deadline (31 December 2018 – 30 December 2021).

### Doctoral Festival of Open Science

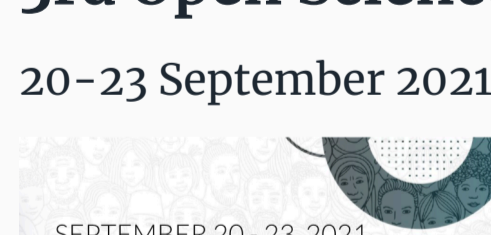
16-18 September 2021, Virtual

20-23 September 2021, Virtual



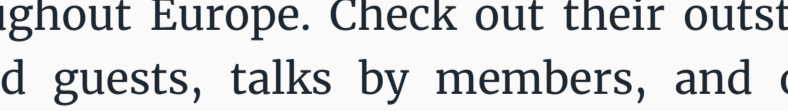
