#### **1-2 working group coordinator(s) for “WG Equitable Opportunities and Sustainable Research Cultures”**

The focus of the working group in 2024/2025 is to

1. draft a policy document that addresses different challenges that must be addressed in order to strengthen equitable opportunities in academia.
2. provide a space for knowledge exchange on what constitutes sustainable research cultures and how to create environments where researchers can thrive in their personal and professional lives.
3. discuss how Eurodoc best can address the intersectional nature of the question.

The working groups meet once every month or every second month as it sees fit. As a coordinator, you are responsible for scheduling and hosting the meetings and for ensuring that the work outlined in the description of the working group moves along.
